Must be within the grade(s) of W1 and W3 OR have a Certificate of Eligibility to become a Warrant Officer..

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of **W1 to W3**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

1. Photocopy of last 5 OERs (Must submit memos for gaps in OERs).
2. Profiles must be attached if applicable. Pregnancy itself is not a disqualifier.
3. Copy of all DD214's / NGB 22's showing all prior service.
4. Security Verification Memo.
5. Certified Selection Board Copy of Soldier Record Brief (SRB)
6. NGB Form 23b, RPAM Statement (National Guard only).
7. Medical Protection System Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) dated within the last 12 months.
8. DA 705 with HT/WT annotated(last 3 APFT annotated). IAW HQDA EXORD 164-20, during the COVID-19 mitigation measures, all current valid passing APFT scores remain valid until further notice.
9. DA 5500 or 5501-R if applicant does not meet HT /WT standards. IAW HQDA EXORD 164-20, during the COVID-19 mitigation measures, all current HT/WT remain valid until further notice.
10. Certificate of Eligibility to Become a Warrant Officer(if not already a Warrant officer)

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 140X

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be T3 ASI (Ground-based Midcourse Defense (GMD) System) qualified.
2. Must be able to obtain a Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI) clearance within 12 months of hire.
3. Must have current Secret clearance with the ability to obtain Top Secret clearance
4. AGR Soldiers on initial tours are stabilized for the first 18 months and are ineligible to apply for this position.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Serves as the C2 Systems Integrator for the only multi-component Ground-based Midcourse Defense Brigade (GMD) capable of the defeating intercontinental ballistic missile attacks against the United States. Provides subject matter expertise to brigade staff and subordinate elements with respect to GMD gunnery program, asset management, system hardware, software capabilities, and TTP development. Updates BDE Tactical SOP, gunnery program, and tactical annex documents. Serves as a conduit between material developers and the warfighter for fielding new capabilities and upgrade training. Coordinates and manages the maintenance deconfliction of strategic level and globally dispersed GMD assets. Assists Space and Missile Defense Command schoolhouse in the development of GMD doctrinal requirements and Army courses. Conducts Organizational Readiness Evaluations of the BDE and BN. Maintains certification as Deputy Director.
