AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open to current members of the Colorado Army National Guard in the rank of 1LT or CPT. Officers must be 90A qualified or able to obtain qualification within one year. Applicants must have a current PHA and possess a current Secret Security Clearance.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION

Qualified applicants must submit applications as described below to their current unit. Unit must provide and forward to the address in the Unit of Activity of this announcement. Applications received after 1700Hrs (MST) on the closing date will not be considered.

- 1. Physical: Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with date of last PHA within the past year.
- 2. Photocopy of last 3 OERs.
- 3. Copy of latest APFT Scorecard (DA 705). Must be less than 12 months old. Profiles must be attached if applicable.
- 4. Copy of RCAS HT/WT History completed within the last 12 months, if not annotated on DA 705. Must have a **DD 5500 or 5501-R** (female) attached if body fat content test required.
- 5. DA Photograph within the last 24 months.
- 6. Copy of Officer Record Brief (ORB).
- 7. Officers who are flagged are ineligible to apply.

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration. US Government postage and envelopes may **NOT** be used for submitting applications. Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. Technicians and AGR must verify with the HRO/AGR Office for job capability.

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration. Applications will be submitted to the Office and Address listed in the upper left hand corner. Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. After recommendation is approved the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation

Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. M-Day Soldiers selected to fill a vacant position, may be assigned to that position and may be promoted provided the Soldier is on a valid EPS list and meet all the promotion eligibility requirements. After recommendation is approved by the G1, the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation. Technicians must verify with the HRO for job compatibility.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Company Commander of a Forward Support Company in 2-135 General Support Aviation Battalion. In command of 76 Soldiers, 3 Platoons, 50+ pieces of rolling stock and GSE. Responsible for the accountability, training, execution, administrative actions, supply, and development of Soldiers. Ensure the Company is prepared to support 75+ pieces of rolling stock, feed 350+ Soldiers, and provide POL support for the Bn. The Company fights as a cohesive unit and is prepared for CONUS and DOMOPS missions. Provides all logistics (less medical) to the Aviation Battalion and serves as the senior multi-functional logistician at the Battalion level. Responsible for the ability of the Company to successfully complete all assigned missions. Responsible for planning and executing individual training for Soldiers and collective training for the Company toward full mission readiness in support of Battalion missions. Responsible for the health, welfare, training, and professional development of Soldiers assigned to the Company. Responsible for ensuring the Company successfully completes all deployment mobilization training requirements.

Minimum Eliqibility Criteria:

Must meet requirements as stated in the "Areas of Consideration". Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions.
