AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

Open to current M-Day members of the Colorado Army National Guard in the Grade of E-7/E-8 with a 31 Series MOS on the current 1SG Best Qualified list. All qualified candidates will be considered. Current NCOES and SSD complete for commensurate grade. Soldiers must either currently hold or be eligible to obtain a Secret security clearance within 1 year of accepting the position. All applicants MUST meet Chapter 3 physical standards IAW NGR 40-501 and AR 40-501. AGR Soldiers must meet CLASP alignment requirements in order to apply. Applicants must have 24 months remaining on enlistment contract or be willing to extend.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION

Qualified applicants must submit applications as described below to their current unit. Unit must provide and forward to the address in the Unit of Activity of this announcement. Applications received after 1700Hrs (MST) on the closing date will not be considered.

- Memo stating why you should be considered for this position, including previous assignments and accomplishments. Please include a good mailing address and contact phone #. Do not exceed 2 pages.
- PHYSICAL:** Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with last Periodic Health Assessment (PHA) within 12 months of closing date of announcement and HIV test less than 24 months old within 30 days after closing date.
- Photocopy of last 5 **NCOERs (memo required for gaps in NCOERs)**.
- Copy of Selection Board Record Brief
- Certified true copy of **ERB with ASVAB scores annotated**.
- Copy of latest **APFT** Scorecard (DA 705) (must be less than 12 months old).
Profiles must be attached, if applicable. Temporary profiles will be accepted on a case by case basis.
- Copy of current RCAS APFT and HT/WT History (minimum 5 years)
 - Must have a **DD 5500 or 5501-R (Female)** attach if body fat content test required.
- NGB 23, NGB 23b** (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard only)
- Copy of current **Driver's License**
- Soldiers that are flagged will NOT be considered.**

Applications without all required supporting documents will be returned without consideration. Applications will be submitted to the Office and Address listed in the upper left hand corner. Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. After recommendation is approved the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation

Qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews. M-Day Soldiers selected to fill a vacant position, may be assigned to that position and may be promoted provided the Soldier is on a valid EPS list and meet all the promotion eligibility requirements. After recommendation is approved by the G1, the chairperson of the selection board will contact all applicants to notify them of recommendation or non-recommendation. Technicians must verify with the HRO for job compatibility.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

31E5M: First Sergeant of a TO&E Detention MP Company with two line platoons, a prisoner operations and HQ platoon; trains and maintains mission readiness of 124 Soldiers capable of supporting the custody and control of inmates assigned to detention/corrections facilities to include the USDB, the only maximum-security prison in the DoD, and deploying and conducting detention operations in support of combat and contingency operations; ensures a command climate that supports Soldiers and their families while fostering individual and unit excellence and success.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

Must meet requirements as stated in the "Areas of Consideration". Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions.
