TOUR DESCRIPTION: Serve as an Analyst for Task Force FireGuard. In this critical role, you will apply military capabilities to domestic emergency response, providing near-real time updates on wildfires across the United States and Canada. Your analysis will provide early detection and situational awareness needed by local, state, and federal firefighting agencies to optimize resource allocation and execute safe civilian evacuations. Duties include monitoring and analyzing data from multiple sources, creating geospatial products to map fire movements, reporting outages, communicating to leadership and external agencies, and answering RFIs.

This position entails shift work of 2am-2pm and 2pm-2am, typically with 4 days on and 4 days off, although this can vary based on scheduling needs. Includes additional education and TDY travel opportunities. Length of orders is flexible, although a minimum 6 month commitment is preferred. Orders are renewed on a year-to-year basis each fiscal year (01 October).

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Security Clearance required at TS/SCI.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open statewide, however, **this position will be based at Buckley SFB in Aurora, CO.** Soldiers and airmen must maintain good standing with their parent unit.

DESIRABLE SKILLS: Strong analytical and critical thinking skills with the ability to process complex data in high-pressure, time-sensitive environments. Strong communication skills, initiative, and ability to identify and address issues with minimal guidance and oversight.
