CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT EDWARD A. HAUSCHILD

Chief Master Sergeant Edward Hauschild is the State Command Chief for the Colorado Air National Guard, Colorado Joint Force Headquarters, Centennial, Colorado. He represents the highest level of Air enlisted leadership and is the principal advisor to the Commander of the Colorado Air National Guard. He is responsible to the commander for readiness, operational utilization, professional development, morale and welfare of more than 1,600 Air National Guard Airmen.

Chief Hauschild enlisted in the United States Air Force in April 1991 as a Munitions Systems Specialist. He graduated Basic Military Training and attended the Munitions Systems Specialist course at Lowery Air Force Base, Colorado. He served 9 years on active duty while stationed at four different Air Force Bases and then joined the Colorado Air National Guard in 2000. He later served as the 140th Munitions Superintendent where he helped create a highly effective team in the Colorado Air National Guard and the Air Guard community. He would eventually serve as the 140th Equipment Maintenance Superintendent and the 140th Maintenance Group Superintendent where he advised commanders on all matters concerning the health, morale, and welfare of 435 airmen. Chief Hauschild has also participated in support of deployments including Operations NOBLE EAGLE, ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM as well as Theater Security Packages in PACAF and European Deterrence Initiatives where he served in numerous leadership roles. Prior to his current position, Chief Hauschild was assigned as the 140th Wing Command Chief, Buckley Air Force Base, Colorado.
