Federally Employed Women’s Military Meritorious Service Award is an annual award given to a maximum of six exceptional military service members, one for each service (Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard) and one for the National Guard, each valued partner with FEW. The Military Awards open season begins April 8, 2022, and closes May 7, 2022. ***Note: Nomination packages submitted after May 7, 2022, will not be accepted.**
