

CSM Miller was born on October 3rd, 1975, on Fort Carson, CO. He grew up in multiple states, eventually returning to CO at the age of 12. CSM Miller joined the Army Reserves at the tender age of 17, in-between his junior and senior year of high school where he completed Basic Combat Training. He then joined the Active Component in 1994, where he attended AIT at Ft. Sam Houston, TX earning two different MOSs, 91B, Combat Medic and 91Q, Pharmacy Technician. He was stationed on Camp Darby, Italy from 1995-1998 and Fort Carson, CO from 1998-1999. He came off Active duty and joined the 2-157th FA BN, Colorado Army National Guard, where he was the medical Platoon SGT until 2006. In 2006, he joined the ranks of the Colorado Army National Guard's AGR program, serving with the COARNG Medical Detachment as the Unit Supply SGT and eventually the State Medical Supply NCO, while also running the clinic as a medic during the week. From 2010-2013 he served as the BN S4 for the 1-157th IN and from 2013-2014 he served as the BN S4 for 117th Space BN. In 2014 he was promoted to MSG, as the 100th GMD BDE S4 until 2016. From 2016-2018 he served as the 89th TC BDE S4 and in 2019 as the G4 NCO, while also completing a Command Leadership and Staff Assignment Policy Program (CLASP) tour as the First Sergeant at D Co, 3-140th AV, from 2016-2019. CSM Miller deployed to Kosovo with 2-135th GSAB in support of KFOR 27 from 2019-2020 as the Aviation Operations NCOIC. He served as the CUOPS/FUOPS NCO for the G3 upon his return and quickly was moved to the 168th Regiment (Regional Training Institute) as an Operations NCOIC. CSM Miller was selected as the Commandant of the Basic Leader Course and the Regimental Command Sergeant Major in November of 2021. CSM Miller has been selected as the 14th Colorado Army National Guard State Command Sergeants Major.
