COLONEL GREGORY T. WHITE

Colonel Gregory T. White serves as the Director of Joint Staff, Joint Force Headquarters, Colorado. In this role, Colonel White directly supervises the Joint Staff and is the commander of the standing Joint Task Force-Centennial, responsible for leading the Colorado National Guard's response to domestic events, as directed by the Governor. Additionally, he directs the Colorado National Guard's partnerships with the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, the Republic of Slovenia, and the State of Israel.

Colonel White received his commission in 1990 as a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy. He has served in numerous operational and staff assignments, primarily in intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (ISR) and space activities. While on active duty he deployed multiple times as an intelligence officer, including service as the Chief of Intel Ops for the 4404th Composite Wing (Provisional) for Operation Southern Watch, and served as an instructor at the United States Air Force Weapons School. Since joining the Air National Guard, he has deployed several times, including as the Senior Intelligence Officer for the 410th Air Expeditionary Wing for the opening of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Colonel White also served as the Director of ISR (NGB/A2 Director), the Air National Guard's Senior Intelligence Officer. He has commanded at the squadron and group level, and served as the Vice Commander of the 140th Wing, one of the largest ANG wings, with F-16, C-21, and Space/Nuclear Command and Control missions.
